Dear Friend

If it is a tradition in your family to go and watch your local hunt meet on Boxing Day, we are asking you to reconsider. You might like to see the horses, the hounds and the riders gather and then leave, but you really wouldn't want to see what they do next. On the front of this card you can see a picture of a fox that was killed by a hunt on Boxing Day last year. The young fox, a female, was running along a hedgerow when she was caught and torn to shreds by hounds. The hunt celebrated. It was an agonising and unnecessary death. Sadly, more foxes will die in the same way this year.

Hunting is a recreation – a pastime. Even though it is illegal, it is widespread. This year, the hunts will be intending to find and kill foxes again. If you provide them with an audience when they leave, you are, essentially, telling them that what they are doing is ok.
