**Pursuing a wild animal
with dogs is ILLEGAL**



HOW TO SPOT IT

Look out for:

- Horse riders, wearing red, green or tweed jackets
- Pack of hunt dogs (hounds)
- People on quad bikes
- **A fox running from the hunt dogs**
- **Blood-covered hunt dogs**

Listen for:

- **Hunt dogs in cry - yelping excitedly**
- Horn & voice calls from the riders, encouraging the dogs
- Shouts from onlookers, showing riders where the fox has gone

WHO TO CALL

If you see or suspect illegal foxhunting:

Tell the hunt sabs - text location to 07443148426

Tell the police. 999 (if crime in progress),
or call 101 or report online

- Note the location
- Note the date&time
- Ask for an incident number

ALSO REPORT

Road chaos: hunt blocking road with horses and vehicles

Quad bikes with no visible number plate

Uncontrolled hunt dogs

Trespass: Hunt dogs, riders, vehicles on private land.
