Who gives the hunt permission to meet on this land? (usually the council that owns it – could be parish, town, district or county)		
Do the hunt restrict the hounds, or are they allowed to run about and interact with children? Give details		
Have there been any dangerous incidents previously? Give details

Where does the hunt meet (use what3 words)		
Who owns the land?		
Do the hunt use public roads to get to the meet?		
Who gives them permission to meet on the land?		
What is their email?		
Private Venue		
Does a pub or other venue host? What is the name of the venue? <i>NB “Host” means that the venue is actually providing a service for the hunt. Sometimes, a local pub is just open at the same time.</i>		
Address and contact details of the venue		
Protests		
Is the meet protested?		
Is the protest organised by a group? Which group?		
Has there been any violence? When?
